This vessel was built in 1945 and classed with the American Bureau of Shipping.

Classification with this Society is desired.

Plans of midship section and general arrangement for this type of vessel have been examined at this Office and the scantlings and arrangements found suitable for the class 100A-.

For further particulars see endorsement 9.5.46.

The NEW YORK Surveyors, on a First Entry Report and Rpt. 8, report (4.47) the scantlings and arrangements verified and the requirements for Vessels Not Built Under Survey and of a Periodical Special Survey partly complied with.

A hinged watertight door is fitted for access to the shaft tunnel.

TO COMPLETE S.S.: The vessel to be examined in dry dock, D.B. tanks under engine and boiler room to be examined internally and all D.B. tanks and deep tanks to be tested, anchors, cables and chain locker to be examined and equipment of anchors and chain cables to be verified with certificates. Tunnel watertight door to be altered to comply with the Rules.

This vessel was examined in dry dock by the American Bureau Surveyors in March 1947.

"Subject to indented shell plating etc. (frames Nos. 30 to 32 p.s) being dealt with at the first convenient opportunity".
