I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 7th instant, the contents of which have been noted.

You may issue the desired certificate, provided the ship ~~is~~ examined in dry dock and found, or placed, in satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage under tow in ballast condition.

The certificate should indicate:

1. That it relates only to the fitness of the hull to be towed.
2. That the ship is unclassified during the voyage.
3. That the towage arrangements are the responsibility of the Owners.

It is concluded that the Society has not been requested to issue a Load Line Certificate for the voyage.
