Fairbanks, Morse & Co., Ltd., and intended for a working pressure of 250 lbs per square inch.

The material has been tested in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

The Receivers have been constructed in accordance with the approved plan and have been tested by hydraulic pressure to 425 lbs per square inch, and found tight and sound.
