to forward the relevant information.

The moment of inertia of the cast steel spare
propellers for the above named vessels has been stated by
the Builders to be as follows:-

m.v. "KRUTYNIA" -

G- 590 Kgs
D- 1798 mm
GD²- 1,907 tm²

m.v. "ORLA" -

G- 588 Kgs
D- 1799 mm
GD²- 1,903 tm²

Certificate of the C.S. spare propeller for the m.s. "KRUTYNIA"-
a copy of a similar certificate for the m.v. "ORLA" is now
not available, but I may add, that the original was sighted
by me before the vessel left the Gdańsk Shipyard.


