In reply to the enquiries contained in your classing letters dated as above, I beg to inform you that a letter was written to the Gdansk Shipyard re moment of inertia of the cast steel spare propeller for the above-named vessels. I shall write to you again as soon as a n answer is received.

The two cast steel spare propellers were made at an approved steelworks at Elblag, but the material was tested and certificates issued by Surveyors to Polish Register of Shipping.

With regard to certificates for the three diesel dynamo sets fitted aboard the "ORLA", I have to advise you that a letter was written to the Hamburg Surveyors asking them to send the required certificates directly to London Office.
