ANSWER

With reference to the Auxiliary Boiler Survey, which became due at the end of June, I shall be glad to learn what arrangements are proposed to be made for this inspection to be carried out.

I would point out that the ship has not been seen in dry dock by the Society's Surveyors since June 1961.

We find that this ship was dry docked at Aioi in June 1962. At that time the Owners advised the shipyard that the Society's class was being withdrawn and it was not necessary to advise us of this docking. As we were not aware of the docking no surveyor saw the ship at that time. Since receiving your memorandum, we have contacted the owners who confirm that the above instructions were given in June but since then they have not decided whether to withdraw from class or not. They have asked that the outstanding surveys required by us be advised to them - please see copy of our letter attached.
