When this new Motorship was recently under survey, the Vancouver Surveyor reported that she had been surveyed by the Norske Veritas with a view to classification with that Institution.

Enquiry has been made of the Oslo Surveyors as to the Owners' reasons for transfer of class, and it appears that objection is raised by them to the form of extra reinforcement required by the Committee for the carriage of fuel oil in the after deep tank.

The Owners recently withdrew another new vessel from class, the "HOEGH SILVERLIGHT", but they re-iterate their preference for Lloyd's Register Class, and have just ordered a new vessel to be built for classification with this Society.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, the 23rd instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and Three Dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
