## CLASSING LETTER

14327 "DJAJAPRATAMA". As recommended, except that a record of SPS 5.65 will be assigned when the saturated steampipes in the boiler smoke boxes have been examined and tested.

I would inform you that the Steampipe Survey was held at Kobe in August, 1964, Report No.13232, but the saturated steampipes in the boiler smoke boxes were not tested and the record of SPS 8.64 was withheld pending this being done. In this respect I would refer you to my Classing Letter of the 5th October, 1964 and your reply of the 24th October, 1964.

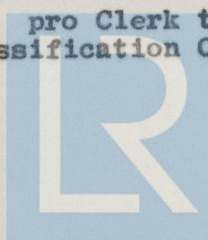
In the circumstances I shall be glad to learn what arrangements have now been made for completion of the survey.

I would add that when imposing a condition of class you should recommend a precise date and avoid the use of indefinite terms i.e. earliest opportunity.
