have surveyed the above-named ship in accordance with the Rules for grounding & Interim Certificate dated Hongkong 23/4/65.

Grounding stated to have taken place on passage between Telok Air Road and Portianak, Borneo on the 9th April, 1965 in loaded condition.

NOW DONE

Bilge & tank sounding book examined at time of grounding and subsequently afloat all found satisfactory. Soundings examined for bilges and tanks on day of present survey all found satisfactory. Rudder swung P & S with satisfactory results. Master stated that no unusual difficulties had been experienced in refloating of vessel or on subsequent passage. It is submitted therefore that vessel's bottom, rudder and sternframe be specially examined and dealt with as found necessary next drydocking on account of grounding.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

We recommend, therefore, that this ship remain as classed ~~xxxx~~ without fresh record of dry docking subject to vessel's bottom plating, rudder and sternframe being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary next drydocking on account of grounding and to all other conditions at present attached to the ship's class being dealt with as previously recommended.
