Further to my letter of the 2nd July, I am pleased to inform you that the survey report in question has come to hand, as the result of which it can now be stated that to complete the Special Survey of the Hull all items are outstanding except the internal examination of the fore and after peak tanks, Nos. 1 & 2 port and starboard deep tanks, No. 1 double bottom tank, No. 4 port and starboard double bottom tanks and cofferdam between Nos. 3 & 4 double bottom tanks. For completion of the Engine Survey all items are outstanding except the Main Engine complete, the outboard and centre generator engines, main condenser, forced draught fan, inboard and outboard fuel oil service pumps and fire/ballast pumps, electrical equipment and the pumping arrangements.
