E. I duly received your letters of the 30th ultimo and 15th instant respecting the air receivers made by Messrs. Brunon-Vallette & Co. for the M.S. "CAMPIERO" building by Messrs. Echevarrieta y Larrinaga, and have to say it is found from the tensile strength and thickness of the material that the air receivers are in accordance with the Rules for a working pressure considerably higher than that intended, and in these circumstances the receivers will be accepted without re-testing.

It is noted that Messrs. Brunon Vallette & Co. are prepared to carry out the Society's requirements for the manufacture of air receivers in future, although they would prefer to the French Navy Specification, and I shall be glad if you will arrange for the Society's requirements to be carried out in all cases.
