Receiver No 5	Tensile 60 Kgs 4 per m/m <sup>2</sup>	- Elongation 22 m/m	<sup>22.3</sup> 3%
- No 7	- 63 Kgs 2 per m/m <sup>2</sup>	- 18 m/m	<sup>18.7</sup> 7%
