Procedure concerning test selections on receivers
tested by Lloyd's Register.-

Following upon our various conversations, we confirm that we greatly desire that the procedure of selecting tests on receivers tested by Lloyd's Register be that we have applied up to the present, procedure which was agreed to by us and your Administration on the occasion of receivers of great capacity supplied, in 1927, to the "Compagnie de Construction Mécanique procédés SULZER," at Paris.-

The receivers that we make are seamless steel. The tests we have carried out up to present are very judicious and permit to verify each receiver through a different test.-

However, in future, we can arrange, if it is required, for the receivers being tested according to the requirements of Lloyd's Register.-
