

Survey Vessel.

G.M.V. "MOANA ROA" was built in 1960 for the New Zealand Government by the Grangemouth Dockyard Co. Ltd., and was their Ship No. 526. The vessel was classed by yourselves for service as a twin screw refrigerated passenger cargo motor vessel. It is now intended to convert the vessel for service as a hydrographic survey ship for the Royal New Zealand Navy.

We are preparing the tendering documents for the conversion, and request your approval of the new structure scantlings.

We are enclosing triplicate copies of the following plans which detail the new structure.

- (1) New Sideshell and Structure in way of redundant hatches.
- (2) Deck Extensions.
- (3) Deckhouse Extensions and Minor Bulkheads.

A further plan showing new bulkheads and deep tanks will be forwarded at a later date.

We are also enclosing for your information a copy of the General Arrangement of the vessel as converted for the hydrographic survey role.

We look forward to receiving your approval of the proposals in due course, but meantime should you require any further information please do not hesitate to contact us.
