Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge receipt of your telegram of the 3rd inst. in connection with the steamers X "CAMPANARIO", "JOSINA", and "MANU", contents of which have been noted.

With regard to the "JOSINA", vessel was at this port for two days to complete discharge and left on the 28th ultimo. We have been unable to ascertain her port of destination but it is believed she is to do coasting trade for the time being. Mr. Larrucea was instructed, therefore, to inform the Owners of the Committee's decision in regard to the vessel and also in regard to the "MANU".
