Completion of DBS. Floating of Waste Heat Boiler  
Safety Valves.

This is to certify that the safety valves of the Waste Heat Boiler of the above named vessel were floated on 9th November, 1963 whilst the vessel was on passage from Newcastle on Tyne to Three Rivers.

The valves were set to lift at 100 lbs/sq.in., the thickness of the compression rings fitted being as follows:-

Forward valve -  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch.  
After valve - 17/32 inches.
