Nature of Survey REPAIRS-TO-ENGINES-AND-BOILERS-DUE-TO-DAMAGE-THROUGH--

The machinery of this Motor Coaster was built in 1939/40 under Special Survey, but the installation was not fully completed owing to hostilities.

The machinery has now been opened out, completely examined and the installation completed.

The vessel has been dry docked and the requirements of LMC and TS surveys carried out.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the Record \* LMC 8.47, OG 8.47.

The Groningen Surveyor should be asked to forward the Bremen First Entry report on the main engine for record purposes.
