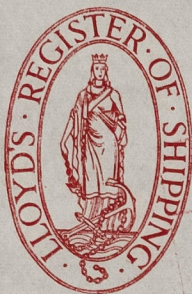

 18th November 1964

and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I
 am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register
 of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following
 survey records assigned ABS 11/64 as previously recommended, subject to the
 Auxiliary circulating pump engine crankshaft, entablature & main bearing
 white metals being renewed by February 1965 (3 months limit), and also to any
 outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.
