**This is to Certify** *that I have surveyed part of the machinery of the S.S. "EMPIRE GANNET" 4260 gross tons of LONDON for CSM and commencement MBS whilst the vessel lay afloat at the Port of Singapore on the 22nd February 1966 and subsequently, and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following survey records assigned CSM (with date) and MBS 2/66 when the respective surveys have been completed subject to any conditions at present attached to the vessel's Class being dealt with as previously recommended.*

Parts now examined:—AUXILIARIES

Starboard F.O. Transfer pump.  
Starboard evap. combination pump.  
Diesel oil transfer pump (in Port E.R.).

NOTE

To complete the MBS for fresh record the Starboard boiler remains to be examined throughout together with its safety valves, mountings, manhole doors and fastenings, the Starboard boiler remains to be examined under steam and its safety valves adjusted and the oil burning system and remote controls remain to be examined working in accordance with Rules.
