With reference to my telephone call with you this afternoon, I forward herewith a copy of the communication which has been received from the Ministry of Transport, and shall be obliged if you will arrange for these cases to receive the necessary attention.

It is understood that the Ministry will be responsible for the fees incurred at Glasgow although the fees for the reinstatement of each vessel's class will ultimately be the Charterers' responsibility.

It is considered that each of these cases should be treated as a partial survey for Re-classification and should it be found necessary to send any further instructions after the cases have been submitted to the technical departments here, I will write you later.
