Further to earlier correspondence in connection with classification of the above named vessel now operating under an "examined" record on a restricted service in the Suez area, which expires at the end of this month, and would advise you that it is the intention to again submit this ship for a further extended General Examination concurrently with periodical overhaul during the course of February, with a view to obtaining a further extension of her present class for a period of up to 12 months.

In this connection we would also refer to recent correspondence and discussions regarding the M.S. "FAUNUS" (a sister vessel) and would state the reasons which made it necessary for us to re-activate the "FAUNUS" apply equally to the "FELANIA". We trust therefore the special circumstances which apply to these ships particularly at the present time, will enable the Committee to agree to our proposal.

The opportunity will be taken to advance the machinery survey also deal with the propeller shaft and boiler surveys concurrently with running repairs.

We shall also be obliged if you will kindly give the necessary authority to your surveyor at Port Said to carry out this examination and upon receipt of your reply, full instructions will be despatched to our Representative at Suez.
