The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to all shell plates .40" and less in thickness within the midship zone being renewed by next Special Survey, and to permanent repairs to indented shell plating (p & s) by next Special Survey.

The last Notation of Special Survey is "No. 1 - 38"

The validity of the "Examined" Notation expires 7.50.

The PORT SAID Surveyor who was authorised reports, the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, and a thorough General Examination for class maintenance carried out and all shell plates within the midship zone .40" or less in thickness renewed.

A considerable number of floors have been renewed.

Minor repairs effected.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel's class be continued with record of docking survey 7.50, and Notation of "Examined 7.50" valid for 12 months be assigned, subject to indented shell plating (p & s) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking.
