With regard to this vessel's forecastle deck and beams, we beg to inform You that in deviation of the approved plans, bulbangle beams $6\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3'' \times .40$ spaced 24" have been fitted and a complete steel deck laid as per plan No. 23.

Kindly return the plans when done with, in order to deal with the sister vessel now approaching completion.
