Dear Mr. Forster,

I am favoured with your letter of the 1st instant, regarding the issue of preliminary certificates, and carefully note what you say.

I have discussed the matter with the Chairman and Deputy-Chairman, and we all appreciate the difficulties which you indicate if we were to insist upon the fees being paid before the issue of these certificates.

In the circumstances it is thought that the case will be met if the words "upon payment of the Society's fees" are inserted after the words "recommended that", so that the last sentence of the certificate will read as follows :- "and that I have recommended that upon payment of the Society's fees she be classed..." etc.

I have therefore to request that in future you will write in these words accordingly.
