"EMPIRE WILSON" 9016 tons gross of GLASGOW, as she lay in Elderslie Drydock Glasgow, on 8th December, 1944, and subsequently, as she lay afloat at Meadowside Wharf, Glasgow, on account of (1) damage stated to have been sustained through vessel striking a quay wall whilst sailing in the River Clyde on 9th December, 1944, preparatory to entering Elderslie Drydock and (2) on account of damage to upper deck beams stated to have been sustained whilst loading cargo in wings of No.5 'tween decks on 15th December, 1944.

and that I <sup>we will</sup> have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's

Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all <sup>temporary</sup> repairs

recommended by me have been completed to my <sup>our</sup> satisfaction, and

that I <sup>we will</sup> have Recommended that she be maintained as previously recommended viz., + 100 A.1. with freeboard, with record of survey 1944 subject to shell plates No.4 and 5, port side, and framing in way thereof, being permanently repaired at Owners' convenience, and to upper deck beams Nos. 64 port and 65 starboard, in No.5 'tween decks, being permanently repaired at Owners' convenience; the vessel's class is also subject to cargo battens being fitted at the first opportunity in holds and 'tween decks.
