I duly received your letter of the 10th instant regarding the case of your steamer "AUDAX" and trust you have by this time heard from Mr. Griffith, the Society's Principal Surveyor for Italy, that, following the receipt of your cablegram of the 9th instant, the Committee have taken the unusual step of instructing that the black line expunging the class should be changed to a red line indicating non-compliance with the Rules.

Your further suggestion now to hand that the Committee should again amend the method of expunging the class by giving you the benefit of withdrawal at your own request, the Committee would be prepared to give consideration thereto provided when the boilers repairs were completed in the spring you will give the Society's Surveyors the opportunity of inspecting them and forwarding a report thereon to the Committee.
