I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for Docking and damage to the rudder stated sustained whilst on a voyage from Floreanapolis to Buenos Aires on the 1st February, 1966 when the vessel shed one propeller blade which resulted in excessive vibration

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

FOUND Rudder top pintle bracket packing pieces loose, lower pintle bush loose, rudder bulb starbd. front plate fractured. Three further fractures were found in way of the shell plate attachment to the propeller shaft bossing.

NOW DONE Rudder top pintle packing pieces formed into solid blocks and machined true, pintle strap cropped and part renewed; lower pintle bush renewed. Fractures in way of shaft bossing (previously welded) now cleaned back to plate material and rewelded.

All repairs were examined and tested to satisfaction on completion.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with ~~XXXXXX~~ fresh record of dry docking 3/66 subject to any conditions at present attached to the vessel's class being dealt with as previously recommended.
