

This is to Certify that I have surveyed the m.s. 'KAREEM' 2213 Gross tons of Karachi for the removal of the first length of anchor cable, adjoining the port anchor, whilst she lay afloat at Colombo, on 18th August, 1965.

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be continued as now classed without fresh record of Survey, subject to 30 fathoms of anchor cable being supplied and 135 fathoms of anchor cable being renewed at the earliest opportunity and to any conditions of class at present outstanding being dealt with as previously recommended.
