

In reply to your letter of 5th inst. re Greenock Report No. 2560 having reference to the Donkey boilers of the M.V. "TREVANION". Plans were approved for two donkey boilers one large and one small to Kincaid's plans one 8.5.43 and 13.5.43 respectively. The large boiler as fitted, but due to a re-allocation, the small boiler fitted was to plan by Alex Anderson of Motherwell and approved 20.10.42.
