DUMBO. — Las Palmas, Dec. 5.—Steamer Dumbo lying horizontally on Alcaravaneras Beach with list to port. At low tide vessel high and dry. Understood position regarding vessel's ownership not yet clear, therefore no attempts made to refloat vessel. (See issue of Nov. 25.)
