Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 19th instant respecting the small motor tanker "SOUTHGATE" and note that she is yet again to be sold.

With regard thereto I shall be glad if you will inform Messrs. Stolk's that the ship is outside her classification trading limits and has not been seen by the Society's Surveyors since July 1954.

The Rules require vessels to be submitted to Annual Surveys at intervals of approximately twelve months, and for maintenance of class such an inspection in dry dock is now essential.

Please obtain their early proposals in this connection and, at the same time, warn them that a full Special Survey will become due at the end of May.
