**General Remarks**

This vessel is well built of good and sound material for the seven years trade, and fastened with Greenails, Yellow Metal, and galvanized Iron bolts & nails in accordance with rule Sect 46, for an additional period of one year, She has a raised quarter deck, built in accordance with rule Sect 38, - Eight pair of diagonal plates fitted & bolted outside the frame timbers 3 1/2 by 7 1/4, 8 feet apart in accordance with rule Sect 39, - The Bilge & thick strakes over the short floor head cheeks are through bolted & clenched in accordance with rule Sect 39, - The windlass is well fitted with patent purchase a double winch is also fitted & all other necessary for the custom voyage, The caulking dried in various parts of the ship & all proved in good condition, Anchors & Chains tested at Staffordshire Public Chain & Anchor, Proving House Mather & Co, Certificates signed, M. R. Procter, Supt dated Oct<sup>r</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> 1877 - Makers, Jones & Lloyd,
