Sir,

I have to acquaint you that the General Committee have had the case of the equipment of the 'Three Gebroeders' (report No. 335) under consideration at their Meeting this day, and I am to add, that in view of the fact that the Auctions are heavier than the weights prescribed for records of her tonnage, and that the Chain cables are <sup>in part</sup>  $\frac{1}{16}$  thicker, the Committee have not allowed the deficiency of 15 fathoms in the length of the Chain to militate against her Claims for the figures by which has been added to her ~~tonnage~~ <sup>gross tonnage</sup> accordingly.
