I am in receipt of your yesterday's letter respecting the S.S. Carenere and in reply to your request for any remarks I had to make respecting the information received by the Committee about the outside-plating being pitted, I beg to repeat what I have stated in my Report viz. that I have examined the Vessel all outside and found all in very best condition.

The slight pitting I have seen in the outside-plating of this little Vessel is in my opinion of no importance whatever, indeed of far less consequence than frequently met with in new Steel Ships of the highest Class.
