Sir,

I herewith transmit to you Reports N^o 1921 of the SS "Carneiro" and beg to state, that these have been prepared for a considerable time, but delayed in consequence of non receipt of plans of the Boilers and Testing Certificates of Anchors and Chain-Cables, which Mr Sharkey, Agent for Owners promised to forward.

Not having received them I think it better to send Reports, and the Plans of the Vessel, which were left here. As Mr Penblon only had the opportunity to give the Machinery a superficial inspection, I doubt whether under the circumstances a Class can be granted - I have further to observe that no Fees have been received here, Mr Sharkey saying that he had said to the London Office.
