
Dear Sir,

BARQUE "DALRYMPLE" OF GLASGOW.

We understand this vessel is now about due for the completion of Special Survey No. 3, and that her spars and rigging were passed in Barry in June last, leaving the hull still to be completed. She is now about due in the United States, and it is our intention to have her dry docked at her loading port and the hull submitted to survey. We shall be glad to hear that if the vessel is found to be in good order internally and externally you will grant us an extension of time for the lifting of the permanent/<sup>close</sup>ceiling, until the vessel's return to this country, it being our intention to bring her back via Australia. The portable ceiling in the hold would all be lifted for the inspection of your surveyors.
