I have forwarded by this evening's Post, Reports of Surveys, numbered from 818 to 824, which I hope will be found correct, a Certificate of Classification, is wanted for the "Livonia," when elapsed,

In reply to your letter of 2^d Instant, I now annex a sketch of the shifts of the Planking of the "Quintin Laited," which shows, what is meant, by two between, and not butted on same timber; I have again to Report, that the Planking is wrought three between mostly, and when two is wrought, I do not consider that it affects the Ship's general strength; and which I hope will prove satisfactory.
