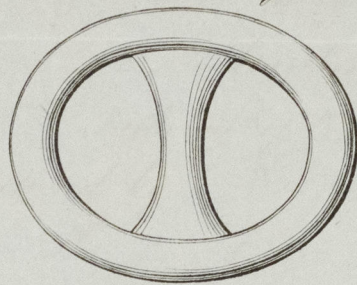


Greenock, 18

We hereby certify, that we have supplied the Mermaid of Andropian belonging to Capt J R Wilson & others with Chains and Anchors as under noted; that the Chain Cables have been subjected to proof strains as follow, viz.

The $1\frac{5}{16}$ inch Chain to a strain of 31 Tons, the $\frac{3}{4}$ inch Chain to a strain of $7\frac{1}{2}$ Tons, and the $\frac{1}{2}$ inch Chain to a strain of $\frac{1}{2}$ Tons; and that on the last link of each fifteen fathoms the proof strain is marked as per margin.
