 on the Barge Vornatin Master John B. Vinton
 Tonnage 353 Built at Glasgow When built 1839
 By whom built Steele Owners William Neilson & Co
 Port belonging to Glasgow Destined Voyage Melbourne
 If Surveyed Afloat or in Dry Dock Patent Slip

Last Survey, No. 2934 Port Glasgow Classed 10 F. 1
 REPAIRS At Present, stripped the Yellow Metal Sheathing and Cleaned the Bottom, Scraped the Upper Works Clean from the Gunwales to the Lower part of the Wale; Gave out Deck and Hold Beam Bolt and Greenails for inspection
Renewed nearly all the Greenails from the Wale to the Bilge; and One Stake of Deck Plank on each side with Yellow Pine and several Deck & Hold Beam Knee Bolt
Painted over all and Sheathed the Bottom with Yellow Metal over Felt to the Second Stake of Wale

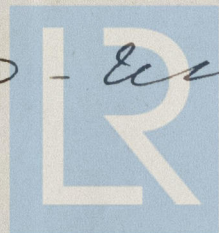
