REPAIRS *This vessel put back to this Port in October last in a very leaky condition. After Discharging her Cargo of Pig Iron and Coke she was put on the Patent Slip and the spine Sheathing stripped and Bottom Rubbed Bright, when the Carboards and Bottom Planks were found to be much Wormed. Recommended the defective Planks to be removed & to Sheath the Bottom with 1 1/2 In. Wood Sheathing over Salt.*
