REPAIRS At present, stripped the Yellow Metal Sheathing and Cleaned

the Bottom

Renewed, six Deck Planks on Starboard Side, viz Five Forward and
One Amidships, Shred Strake from Waterways; A number of Hold
Beam Planking since Bolted, repaired and renewed Three Iron
Breasthooks which were broken in Lower Hold, Unshipped the Windlass
and repaired and replaced, also Fire Hatchway Coverings
Additionally Bolted the Upper Transoms and three Yellow Metal Bolts
in Nelson Amidships

Caulked over all and Resheathed the Bottom with Yellow Metal over felt
