REPAIRS At Present, Shipped the Yellow Metal Sheathing, Cleared the Bottom, removed the Mice of the Head, Ribs, Cheek &c, Rubbed the Stem Bright and relatched the Through Bolt, Fitted a Head Mice, Cheek, Ribs &c

Renewed on the Starboard Bow, One Fore Shift of Mule Plank, Two Blackstrakes, One Top Side and Two Shifts Aft on the Quarter Lumber Oak, One on Starboard Bow Fore Head Black Strake and Outside Planking of Topgallant Forecutter Starboard Side, Oak Caulked from Keel over all

Resheathed the Bottom with Yellow Metal over Felt sewed Fore Mast and Top Mast and Lower and Running Rigging all new; Some new Sails, others repaired and made good
