The machinery of this vessel opened out for survey and examined overall parts - cylinders, pistons, slide valves pumps, crankshaft & shafting, also the main & donkey boilers, safety valves, pipes &c. - New propeller & shaft fitted - The old propeller shaft which was broken was replaced by the spare one during last voyage. Shaft now removed is carried as spare - When vessel was in Dry Dock the sea connections &c were all examined

General Observations, Opinion, and Recommendation :—

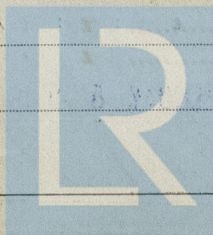
