 A few rivets in bow plating east side started & now renewed. A plate in the starboard inside bilge stake amidships being indented, now repaired inside by removal of the close ceiling & cement. but as it was found not to be materially damaged it has been now covered up again.
 The Forepeak tank tested as reqd by Rules & found water tight.
