Sir

With reference to your letter of yesterday, directing that in future the weights of anchor stocks should be stated upon First entry Reports, I beg to say that the "Glaucus" had sailed for Liverpool before the arrival of your letter, taking the anchor test certificates with her. Hence having taken no note of the stocks of the two Kedge anchors - they being 25pc of the weights of the anchors - I have not been able to state their weights in the First entry report of "Glaucus" forwarded to you this day.
