I am in receipt of your favor returning Certificate of the $\frac{9}{16}$ " Cable, which I again return to you, you will please draw the Surveyors attention to the fact that the $\frac{3}{4}$ " Cable is 2qrs, 26lbs, over-weight, and as the $\frac{9}{16}$ " Stream Chain is only 25lbs short-weight leaving 2qrs, 11lb in excess of Lloyds rules I think he will receive the Cables or otherwise write Lloyds in London, for their instructions in the matter, when I feel confident they will allow the $\frac{9}{16}$ " Cable to be received as I always do my utmost to carry out Lloyds instructions as far as possible.
