I wrote a hurried letter last week
having just received your Cable message re
"Cedarbank" - After consideration I called you
as follows on August 13th at 10.45 Am.

From Almutium

To Committee
London

"Divers report bottom "Cedarbank" sound but
bare - rudder damaged must be unstopped
Could be done afloat - Reply if must dry
dock here.

To this message I have as yet received
no reply - indeed I hardly expect any, as Captain
Guineaditch (representing the owners) has received
instructions to proceed with the discharge of
the vessel and dry dock &c - the date
of this message is August 11th and
this course will now be followed.

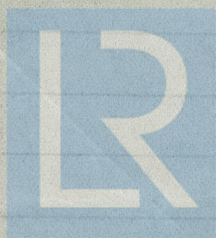
