the moulded depth of the "Tourquennois", I
beg respectfully to point out that 11'-9½"
as stated in the report is correct, and that
it agrees with the actual depth from top
of floors to top of main deck beams.

11'-0" + 1'-4" = 12'-4". Moulded depth 11'-9½" +
6½" round of beam = 12'-4"

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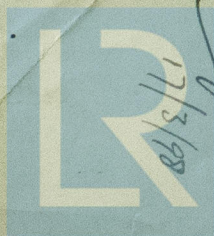
