REPAIRS, &c. This vessel is stated to have taken the ground on the coast of Holland, on her passage to Newcastle. On reaching the Yorkshire coast she began to make water in the Engine room, the weather being stormy. The Master deemed it prudent to put into Whitby to ascertain the extent of damage sustained. On examination one edge of riveting under Port Plate found to be started, the water running in at lap of plating to the extent of about 5 ft in length. Recommended a plank of Oak be bolted to the outside and caulked in length about 9 ft. When done the vessel to proceed on her voyage to the Tyne to repair.
