Hold cleared, timbers and all air courses cleared, the ceiling equal to one strake fore and aft on each side removed, also the man hole covers to tanks; and the cement found good and adhering satisfactorily to the iron; all the inside of the vessel including, peaks, bunkers, bulk^{as} frames, floors and top of tanks, chipped, cleaned & painted, the tanks satisfactorily tested to the light line, and the ceiling refitted; Bottom cleaned and painted.
